INSTALLATION

- 1. Begin by placing the vehicle on a lift or four jack stands at maximum height to aid in an easier installation.
- Cut the factory system close to the bend that leads to the muffler. This will give you the maximum amount of 2. material for adjustments.



- 3. Now, it's time to install the Pypes Street Pro Touring axleback. Slide the HVC21 band clamp over the slotted portion of the Pypes axleback. Install the wire forms into the factory rubber hanger followed by the expanded end of the Pypes axleback onto the pipe you just cut.
- 4. Finish by sliding the expanded portion over the factory piping. Be sure to file or grind off any metal burrs from cutting. Align the tip in the valance opening and tighten the HVC21 clamp.
- 5. Repeat the same steps on the other side. For the best fit, weld all the slip joints. The stainless steel can be welded with your standard mig welder, and is highly recommended when possible.
- 6. Start your Mustang and check for leaks.
